Notable Experience & Cases

2023

CONTENTIOUS Acted for a white knight investor in the resuscitation efforts of a company listed on SGX's Catalist board in a dispute with its shareholders.

CONTENTIOUS Successfully represented USP Group Limited, an SGX-Mainboard listed company, on a question of law on the "membership" of a company, which arose from a EGM requisition under section 176 of the Companies Act seeking to replace the directors on the company's Board of Directors.
