CONTENTIOUS Successfully defended a childcare centre in a personal injury claim, negotiating a reduction of over 50% in the overall claim amount. Additionally, secured an agreement for complainants not to disclose details of the personal injury claim as part of the settlement.

CONTENTIOUS Defended a stepfather in a contested POHA application who was accused of committing violence against his special needs stepchild by the said child's biological father. Successfully negotiated for the child's father to withdraw the POHA application and all police complaints made against the stepfather and the child's mother and obtained a settlement agreement that offered protection to all members of the mother's household including the stepfather.
