Notable Experience & Cases

2025

CONTENTIOUS Successfully resisted, both at first instance and on appeal, an application for unless order premised on alleged non-compliance with a production order.

CONTENTIOUS Successfully obtained a worldwide Mareva injunction for S\$ 1.7 million in a claim by the executrix of an estate. The claim involves allegations of breach of fiduciary duties, resulting trust, undue influence and unconscionability.

CONTENTIOUS Represented the executrix of an estate sued in her personal capacity in defending a claim for an account of rental monies from a coffeeshop. Involved arguments on resulting trust and common intention constructive trust.

CONTENTIOUS Represented a company in an originating application to invalidate a notice of EGM. Successfully defended an application to strike out the originating application, both at first instance and on appeal.
